Dear Ms. Corri~~v~~eau:

During our fast tour of the Gail School I came to the conclusion that the structure is sound and very movable.

I and the Gail School team looked over the area and found a route on which the Gail School could be moved.

The move would require a width of 50 feet if we are to not remove any of the original building. There are some trees which would have to be removed however the large Red Oak behind the new building could stay. The small single family house near the main school building (on the opposite side of the drive) would have to be moved off its foundation; the foundation taken down to ground level and the set back on and reconnected to the foundation and the utilities after the Gail School is moved. There are a number of utility poles which have to be moved down School Street, etc.

From what I have seen to date, I feel the Gail School could be moved for \$150,000.00 plus \$9,000.00 for the small house move; \$25,000.00 to 35,000.00 for right of way, poles, wires, etc. and \$45,000.00 to \$55,000.00 for site work and foundation.
